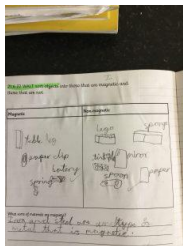

We have been listening carefully to the story and working hard to answer questions. Our DT unit this half term, is textiles. So far, we have practised a running stitch. Miss Aston was very impressed with our sewing skills. We are looking forward to creating our bunting in the next few lessons.

This week in Birch Class, we have been very busy! In English, we have been learning about the features of a letter and we will be writing letters to our new class teacher soon. In Maths we have been working with decimal numbers. We have revised skills such as rounding decimals to the nearest whole number, and we have been comparing and ordering decimal numbers.

Elm class have been enjoying learning about samba music. The Year 4 children have been participating in MAD sessions each Friday. Year 5s have been learning how to swim each Tuesday and they have been enjoying football sessions on a Friday with our coach, Elliot. Our class are very excited to be making cushions in our textiles unit. We have been busy creating our designs which are shown below.

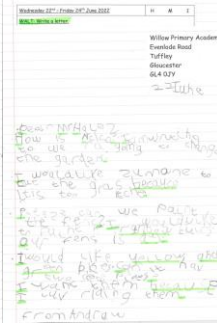
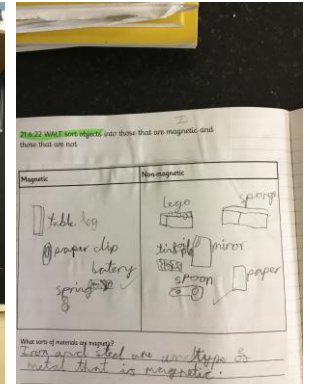
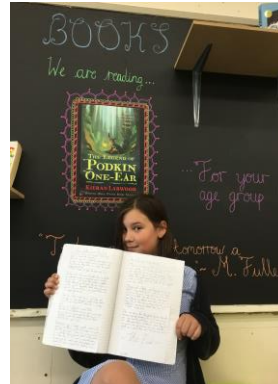
Oak

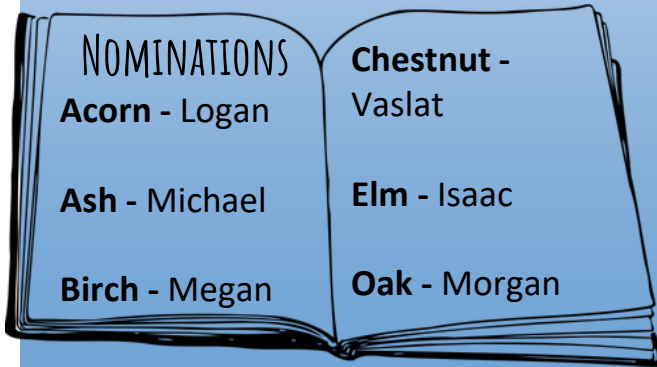
