
# Parent & Carer Survey

## **Happy Children**






85% of respondents feel that there child is happy at school



#### Safe Children






88% of respondents feel that their child is safe



## **Progress of Pupils**






88% of respondents feel that their child makes good progress



## **Well Taught**






88% of respondents feel that their child is well taught. This is an increase on the previous survey



#### Recommendation






92% of respondents would recommend this school to other parents / carers. This is an increase by 16%



## **Leadership and Management**






85% of respondents feel that leadership and management is strong. This is an crease by 30%
