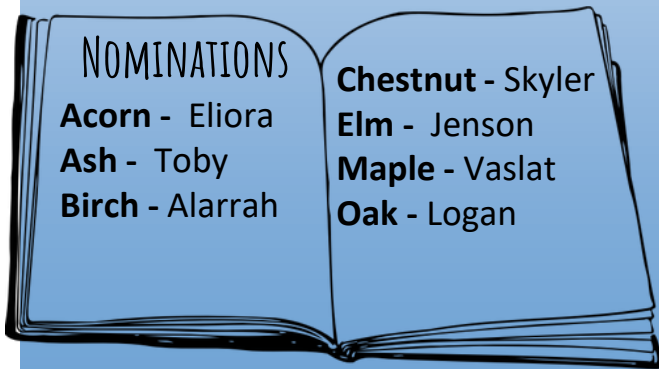

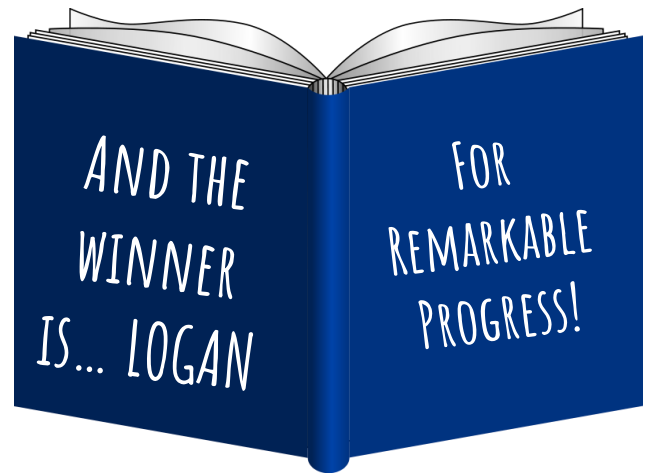




WILLOW'S STAR READER SPECIAL SURPRISE AWARD
