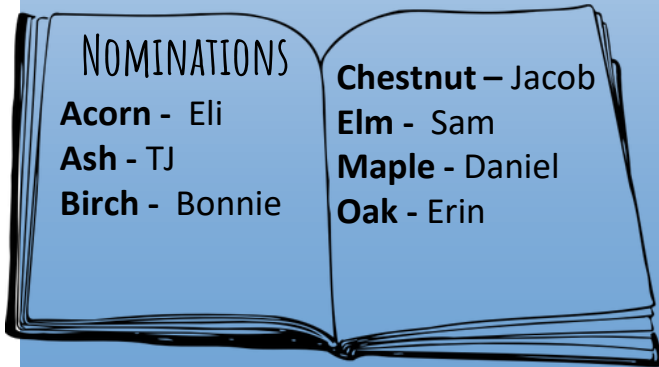

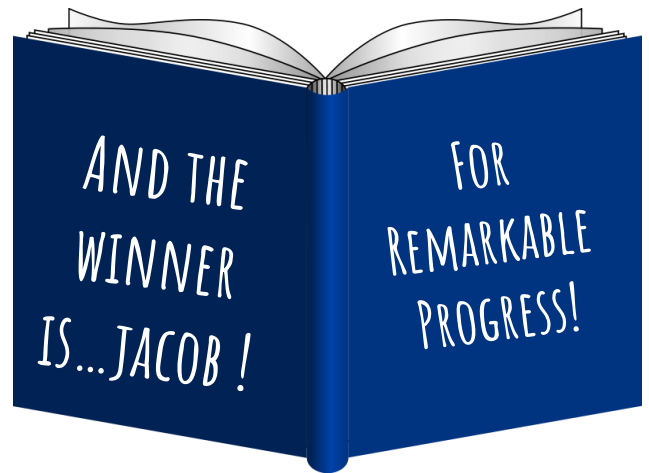




WILLOW'S STAR READER SPECIAL SURPRISE AWARD



STAR READER...

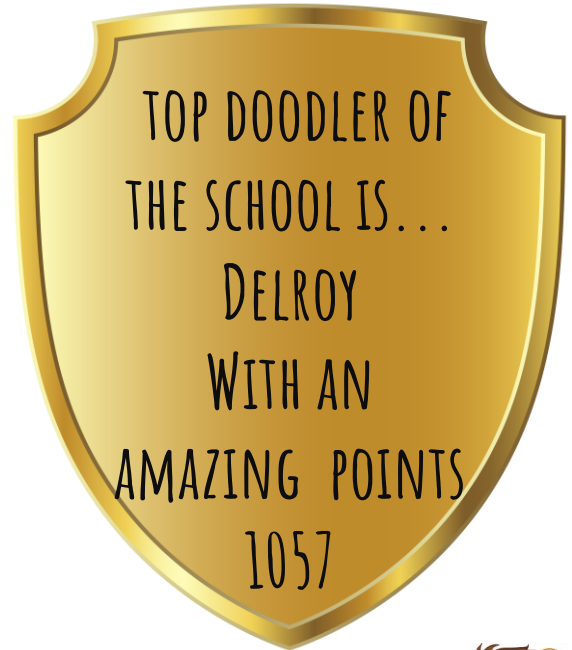
