Dear Parents / Carers

What a fantastic first week back we have had at Willow Primary Academy.

During this week we have had a full school review which was undertaken by Dr Jan Saunders and Sarah Campagnaro from Cabot Learning Federation. This review began on Monday 5th June with an intensive phone call to members of the Senior Leadership Team. The team then arrived on the morning of Tuesday 6th June and looked at the following areas of school:

- Safeguarding an safeguarding culture
- The leadership and teaching of phonics and reading
- The leadership and teaching of writing
- The leadership and teaching of science

The main areas of strength that were found were as follows:

- Willow has a strong culture of safeguarding and ensures it does everything possible to ensure the safety of your child
- The use of the PRIDE values as a guide for children to help them understand how to be responsible citizens
- There is a clear rationale for the teaching of phonics and reading and is impacting upon pupil progress
- The support given to children in the Early Years. The processes and systems we have support our youngest learners for the next phase of their education
- All pupils spoke confidently about their learning in school
- Throughout the visit there was a calm and conducive learning environment
- Al staff are on board with the journey that Willow is embarking upon

My favourite comment we received was:

"We had a lovely day at Willow, and you can feel a real sense of everyone driving for the same goal. By and large, what we saw feels like you should be seeking a good"

This shows the positive steps we have taken to move the school forward.


Reminder
