Safeguarding Responsibilities

The main safeguarding document relevant to schools is 'Keeping Children Safe in Education', strongly states that 'safeguarding is everybody's responsibility'. Safeguarding means keeping children safe from harm or neglect. There are lots of ways in which we safeguard children. These include: making sure the school site is physically safe, supporting families with varying needs, ensuring children are able to talk to an adult if they feel unsafe and ensuring that safeguarding underpins the culture and ethos in school. 


