Safeguarding Safety Tip of the Week

This week our focus is on the PANTS rule. The talk PANTS campaign was introduced by the NSPCC to help children understand that their body belongs to them, and they should tell someone they trust if anything makes them feel upset or worried. PANTS is a simple and clever acronym devised to teach children the underwear rule: Privates are private; Always remember your body belongs to you; No means no; Talk about secrets that upset you and Speak up, someone can help. 


