# Safeguarding Safety Tip of the Week

#### **Coercive Control**

Coercive control is a form of domestic abuse that can often be overlooked. Some examples of coercive control are: controlling and isolating behaviours, using threats and coercion, emotional abuse, or economic or financial abuse. Although it is usually mainly adults who are affected, children can also be impacted by this type of abuse. Some of the impacts may be: parents and carers describing children as quiet, stressed and depressed; behaviour changes including children emotionally and physically abusing parents and siblings; children expressing worries and fears about their parent and carer's coercive and controlling behaviours; some children engaging in self-harm and disruption to children's social and support networks. 








STAR READER...
