Looking for a recipe that can get your children to eat more vegetables?

Ingredients:

- 1 large red onion
- 3 cloves of garlic (2 tsp pre-minced)
- 1 can sweetcorn
- 1 can black beans (drained and rinsed)
- 1 can chopped tomatoes
- 320g frozen spinach
- 100g uncooked red lentils
- 250g brown rice
- 600ml veggie stock
- 120g low-fat cheddar/mozzarella

 Spices: 2 tsp paprika, 1.5 tsp cumin, 1.5 tsp coriander, 1 tsp oregano, ½ tsp chili powder (or none if you don't like spice).



Method:

- Pre-heat your oven to 200 degrees/ gas mark 6.
- Dice the onions and garlic (if using fresh) and add them to a large baking tray or dish.
- Add your brown rice and lentils, along with the spinach, corn and chopped tomatoes.
- Add all your spices to the tray. Make the stock, then pour slowly into the tray and mix everything together.
- 5. Pop into the oven for 45 minutes.

 Take the tray out, add beans and mix well, then top with grated cheese.

 Return to oven for 10 minutes.
- 6. Leave to cool for 5 minutes and then enjoy!




