

#### **WORLD BOOK DAY**

On Thursday, we had a great day celebrating World Book Day! The day consisted of lots of reading activities:

- Year groups paired up, so that pupils could share their favourite book with one another
- A Year 1 child was so inspired by the book that was shared by a Year 4 pupil, that he went home and read his own copy with his Mum at bedtime! We LOVE to hear success stories like this!
- We had an EYFS/Ks1 assembly where the class teachers read picture books and a KS2 assembly where teachers read an extract from their favourite book – most of these were favourtite books from when the teachers were younger – I wonder which book YOUR child will remember when they are an adult?
- Each class had a 'Mystery Reader' They arrived during lesson time and everything had to STOP, so that the children could relax and listen to the story – The children LOVED this! The Mystery Readers were: Miss Simmonds, Mrs Tonks, Mr Hales, Miss Martin, Mrs Arthur and Mrs Sullivan. 




